

Supply Chain Policy

Our Supplier Code of Conduct sets out our expectations for responsible sourcing and supply chain due diligence throughout the commodity value chain for our clients.

Our Supplier Code of Conduct applies to any individual, organization or company that provides and sells materials to GMI companies, including goods and services.

We will reference the Supplier Code of Conduct (published on the GMI website) in all of our contracts and onboarding materials.

Our approach supports the identification, prevention and mitigation of potentially adverse impacts that could negatively affect people, environment, or company reputation. It ensures the responsible and ethical sourcing and production of the minerals and metals that we bring to market, as well as meeting external expectations and complying with regulations.

Our commercial teams supply and source commodities from third-party suppliers, with our traders regularly visiting industrial sites. We promote cooperative networks within GMI to ensure we incorporate lifecycle management into all phases of production and sales. Our traders meet with our customers regularly to share advice on process safety and best practice.

It is an ongoing process to identify and address actual or potential risks in order to prevent or mitigate adverse human rights impacts in our supply chain. If a high level of risk is identified, we work with the supplier to determine appropriate corrective action until both parties agree the desired outcome has been achieved within an agreed timeframe.
